More than we can know.

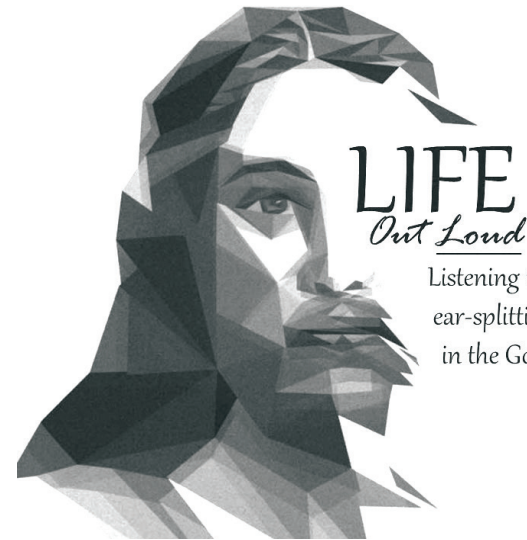
We know the great God.
